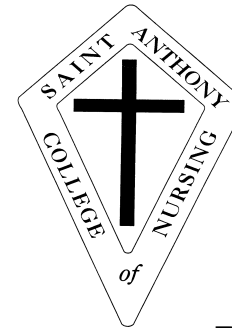

Admission Requirements for RN to BSN Program
