* A student may apply for admission after completing: 32 prerequisite credits, at least one of the prerequisite nursing sciences, with a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5 and a nursing prerequisite science (A & P, college chemistry and microbiology) GPA of at least 2.7 on a 4 point scale
